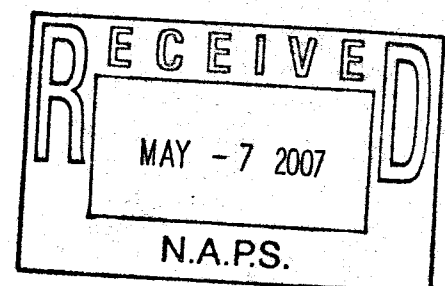


Gentlemen:

This is to advise you of recent action being taken to address the issue of vacancy files which have been "dormant" for some time with no action having been taken on filling the vacancy. Postal Service Area Managers, Human Resources have been advised that effective immediately vacancy files over 120 days old are to be closed and returned to the district. Currently HR Shared Services informs the District Manager, Human Resource each month of vacancy packages that remain open in an effort to facilitate processing of the package. If the district needs additional time to complete the processing for a particular vacancy the District Manager, Human Resources is to advise Nancy James, Manager Human Resources Shared Services Center of the need for the exception with anticipated date of completing the package for the particular vacancy.



I'm sure you will recall this issue was a topic of discussion when you were briefed in December 2006 on the HCE EAS Selection System.
